- Research Associate:** any person who has earned a bachelor's degree, is currently employed in an academic institution or industry under the supervision of a lab director or academic mentor, but is not formally enrolled in a graduate school program. Research associates are not eligible for competition in the graduate student category (unless a student).
- Post-Doctoral Fellow:** any person who has earned a doctorate degree and is currently conducting research under the supervision of either an academic advisor or working under the supervision of a PhD researcher in industry.

  - 5) Word limit: 300 words excluding title, institution and author names.
  - 7) Abstract deadline is **midnight, Thursday, September 19, 2019**
