[May 15, 2013 Legislative Update: NIH Finalizes FY 2013 Budget, Congress Moves Forward on FY 2014](#)

NIH released complete fiscal policy information on the agency's FY 2013 operating plans. As a result of the sequestration, the NIH budget for FY 2013 falls to \$29.15 billion, a \$1.6 billion or 5.5% reduction from FY 2012. Research Project Grants decline by 6.1%, including reductions of 4.9% for noncompeting awards and 8.6% for competing awards. NIH expects to fund more than 1,300 fewer grants this year, including 703 newer grants. The agency will likely fund continuing awards at reduced levels and there will be no inflationary adjustments (a continuation of existing policy)...

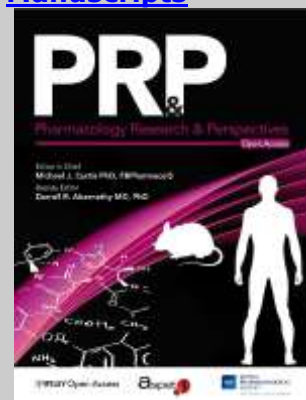

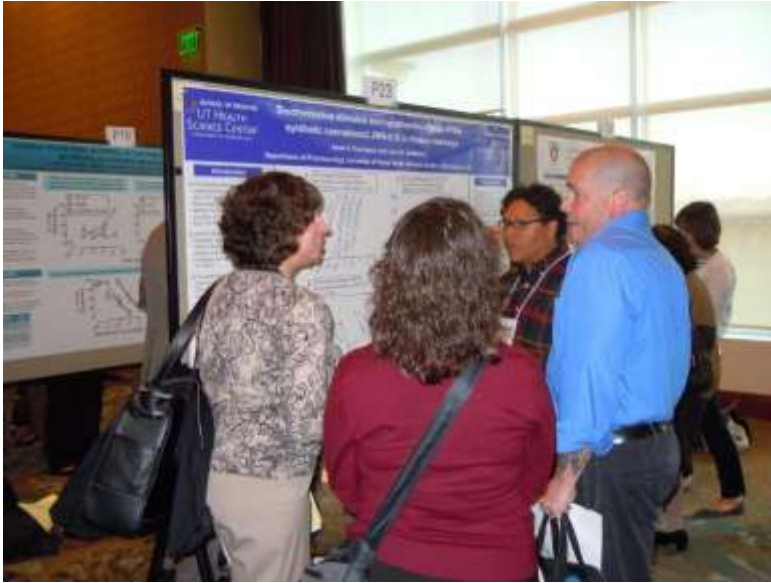
